\$17,000 needed to purchase Officer Dotson's retirement time while on military leave.

Reviewing/updating SOPs.

Responding to and investigating heroin overdoses.

Less lethal shotguns

Motor vehicle accidents involving emergency and public safety vehicles.

Emergency removal of a child from parent/home.

Ongoing security meetings/drill planning with LCS for full scale fall exercise involving active shooter.

Cross training with LFD medics for "warm zone" entry

Researching/replacing cruiser MDTs with tablets.
