PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 114-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LAW DIRECTOR TO APPLY FOR SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL GRANTS FOR A NON INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT FOR SRTS I & II

WHEREAS, the following is a resolution enacted by the City of Lancaster Fairfield County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside monies for Safe Routes to School Projects through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, LPAs can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to apply for a non infrastructure grant not to exceed \$100,000.00 for SRTS I and SRTS II; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO.

SECTION 1. The Law Director of the said LPA is empowered on behalf of the LPA to prepare and execute an application for SRTS funds for the stated non infrastructure project described project and to submit same to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2. The total cost of the project is established not to exceed \$100,000.00, of which the LPA, if awarded the funds, the LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the project cost over and above the maximum amount provided by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

SECTION 3. Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal laws, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described Project; (3) if necessary, maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) if necessary, hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION 4. If the application is approved for the funding the Law Director of said LPA is hereby empowered on behalf of the LPA to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
