The Lancaster Fire Department is seeking donations to construct a fire safety house to be located behind Engine House #3. The safety house will be primarily used to educate the children in our Community about fire safety. It will also be used as the location for our Juvenile Firesetter Program, which is designed to provide additional help to children with fire setting problems. Additionally, it will be used to provide educational opportunities for adults and seniors.

Our goal is to raise \$100,000 through donations and grants. We believe that we can provide an excellent educational experience for the Community with this fire safety house.

For a donation of \$5000 or more, you will be considered a major contributor and your name or company name will be put on a plaque and posted on the front of the building. For a donation of \$1000 to \$4,999, your name or company name will be put on a framed roster and posted in the building. All other donations will be listed in a register and be placed in a location for public viewing.
