## Citizen Police Academy Introduction

**TITLE:** Citizen Police Academy (CPA) – fall 2010

**DATES:** CPA starts on Thursday, September 9, 2010 and will graduate on Monday, November 15, 2010. No class will be held the week of the Fairfield County Fair. Unless otherwise notified, class will be held each Thursday evening from 6:00 – 9:00 p.m. for nine weeks. The firearms and range portion of the class are from 6:00 – 10:00 p.m.

**LOCATION:** Most classes, including the first one, will be held at the Lancaster Police Department – 130 S. Broad St. Lancaster, OH. Please report to the front lobby at least 10 minutes before class is scheduled and notify a clerk or the duty officer of your arrival.

**STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:** Each student must be 21 years of age. Applicants with questionable criminal records will be admitted only upon approval of the chief of police. Attendance is required; however, a student may receive two authorized absences. The class will be limited to 20 students. Each student must complete an application. In addition to class attendance, each student must complete two-four hour police ride-a-longs and you have the opportunity to observe our dispatch/911 center.

**STUDENT BENEFITS:** The student will receive an overall, yet comprehensive, understanding of the operations of the department. The sessions will help to create a greater awareness of the police role and departmental mission in the community. The student will be able to learn how to effectively work in partnership with the police and to recognize and address neighborhood issues to make them safer. Upon graduation, students have the option to join the Lancaster Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association, which is a non-profit group comprised of approximately 40 graduates that perform varied voluntary tasks and represent the department at special events.
