

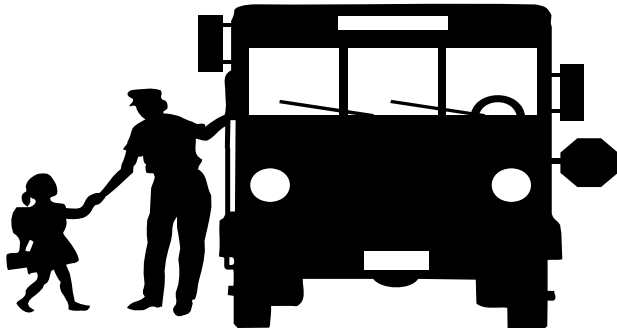


Registration For Safety Town

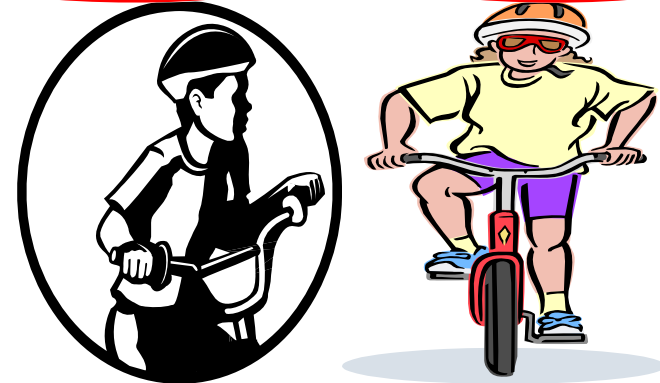
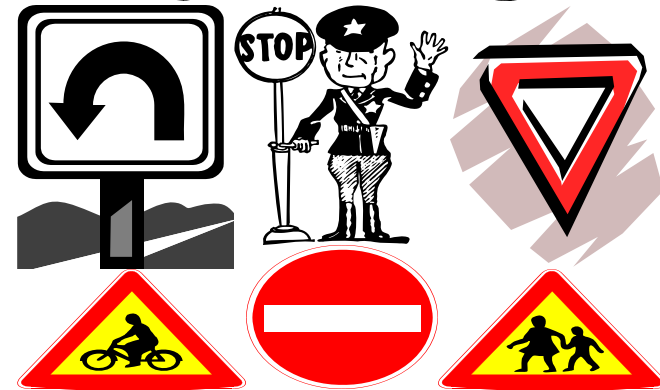
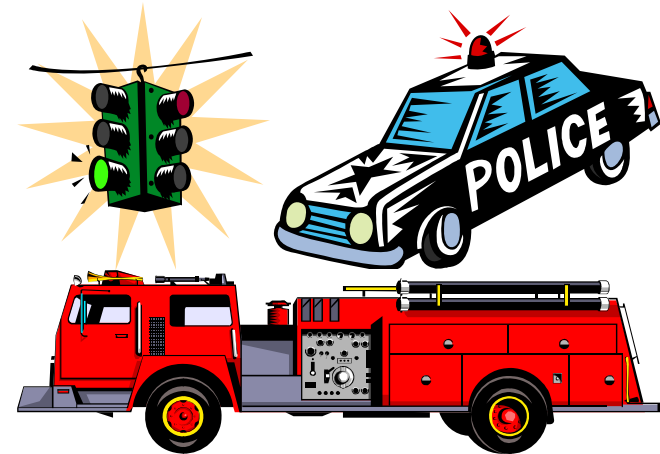

WHAT IS SAFETY TOWN?

Safety Town was developed in 1986 as a two week summer safety program designed for children entering Kindergarten.

Approximately 250 children attend each year to learn to make wise decisions in potentially dangerous situations as well as handle emergencies in their young lives.

Students also learn pedestrian safety by negotiating a miniature village on tricycles. The village is made up of streets, sidewalks, buildings, stop signs, and a fully functional traffic light.

WHEN AND WHERE IS SAFETY TOWN?

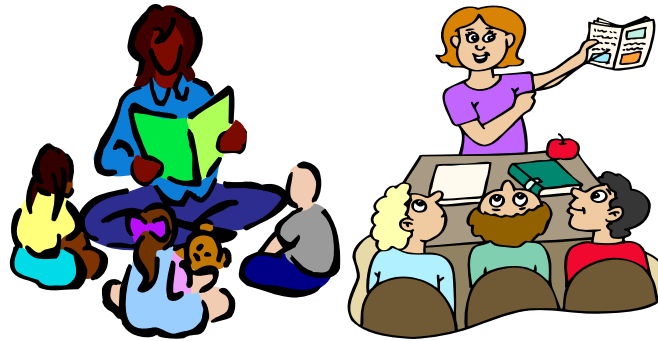
Safety Town is located at Medill Elementary School 1151 James Rd. Lancaster, Oh. The morning session is from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, and the afternoon session is from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Graduation for Safety Town is held at Thomas Ewing Junior High, 825 East Fair Avenue. The graduation ceremony is held on the final Friday of Safety Town and the children wear their Safety Town T-shirts and a graduation cap. The ceremony includes a D.J. and guest speakers, including the Chief of Police and the Mayor.

WHO CAN ATTEND SAFETY TOWN?

Children throughout the City of Lancaster and Fairfield County that will be entering Kindergarten at the beginning of the next school year are the only children eligible to attend Safety Town.

These children must be enrolled in the City of Lancaster or Fairfield County schools and must be 5 years old prior to September 30th in order to register.



WHAT DO CHILDREN LEARN AT SAFETY TOWN?

Safety Town is a unique opportunity for children to be acclimated to a classroom environment. Students at Safety Town receive a two week introduction to a classroom setting, which lessens the anxiety of separating from parents to teachers for the next school year.

Safety Town Students learn basic rules of pedestrian and traffic safety. Students also learn about fire prevention, school bus safety, poison/substance avoidance, animal safety, electrical safety, water safety, playground safety, bicycling and helmet safety, seat belt safety, and stranger danger.

Safety Town is a unique teaching environment. Each day includes a guest speaker who is a certified professional in his/her area of expertise

WHO TEACHES SAFETY TOWN?

Classroom teachers at Safety Town are certified teachers from Lancaster City and Fairfield County Schools. Our teachers are assisted by college and local high school students.
