

MOBILITY PASSPORT PROGRAM

Mobility Passport is a FREE program available for individuals over the age of 65 or individuals that have a permanent disability. The passport allows for eligible community members to ride at a reduced rate of \$1.00 per ride with an advanced reservation.

**THERE IS NO DISCOUNT FOR A SAME DAY RIDE.*

Eligibility requirements

Senior Citizens:

- *Must show valid proof for date of birth:
 - Driver's License
 - Birth Certificate
 - State ID

Permanent Disability:

- *Social Security Award Letter or
- *Letter from a medical physician stating permanent disability.

To Enroll

Apply in person at the LPTS office
Tuesday or Thursday
9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
Must have proof of eligibility to apply.

Important Information

If you require an accessible vehicle, please inform the scheduler when you schedule your ride. All riders are required to wear safety belts when riding, and children under 40 pounds, and/or under the age of 4 years old are required to be secured in an approved child safety seat. Please inform the scheduler if you cannot provide a child safety seat so that LPTS may provide one for you.

RIDER TIPS...

- ◆ LPTS does not permit the following in our vehicles: smoking, eating, spitting, drinking, offensive language, offensive behavior, and carrying weapons.
- ◆ LPTS does not provide personal care attendants for disabled riders, but will permit a PCA to accompany a rider at no charge. Please inform the scheduler if a PCA will be accompanying the passenger.
- ◆ Each passenger is limited to four (4) bags of groceries. Any article not in a bag is considered one bag. Additional bags are permitted at \$.50 per bag.
- ◆ Refusal to ride the vehicle sent for a trip is considered a "no-show". A rider must pay for his/her no-show before riding again. Vehicles will wait 5 minutes for a rider before trip is considered a "no-show".
- ◆ If you must cancel a ride, please notify LPTS at least thirty (30) minutes before your pick-up time or you will be considered a "late-cancel" and charged the appropriate fare.

LANCASTER PUBLIC TRANSIT SYSTEM

Lancaster Public Transit System (LPTS), started in 1976 to primarily benefit Lancaster's senior citizens. It has grown to serve the entire community. We are dedicated to excellence in the provision of safe, reliable and affordable transportation; carried out in a friendly and courteous manner.

Currently, LPTS provides demand response, curb-to-curb, advance or same day reservation, and shared ride transportation service. Our service area consists within all Lancaster city boundaries, with service offered to a five-mile radius from the center of the city (referred to as Zone 1 and Zone 2 below). The limited service area outside of the city is represented in the Fairfield County Fare Structure.

To schedule a ride, call 681-5086, Monday through Friday, 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. or on Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

For a reduced fare, call a day or more ahead to reserve your ride (*Advanced Reservation*). An advanced reservation also means you are picked up within a (15) minute window of the scheduled pick-up time.

A same day reservation, if space permits, may extend the pick-up wait time to 30-60 minutes from your negotiated time. Also, there is no guaranteed arrival time.

Service Area Fare Structure

Advanced reservations secures the lowest fares. Exact change is required; the drivers do not carry change.

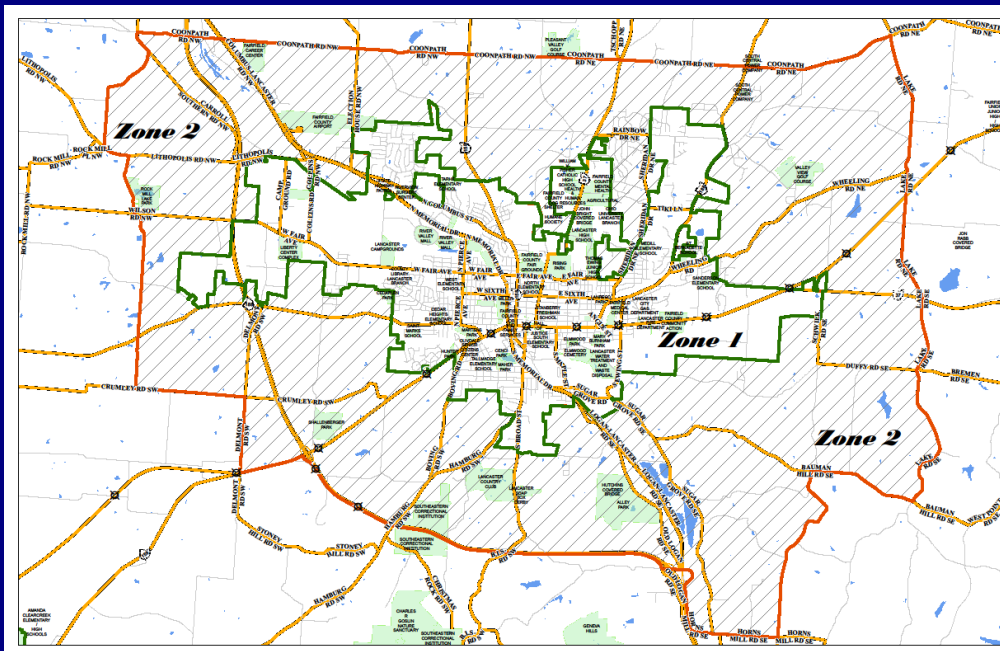
Children

Ages 0-4, two children are permitted to ride free with one adult fare.

Ages 5-14, two children are permitted to ride for 1/2 price with one adult fare.

Ages 15 and over are required to pay full rate. Additional children are full rate.

Same day rides are available for entire service area.



Fairfield County Fare Structure

As space permits, Lancaster Public Transit System will offer transport to the general public within Fairfield County. A 48 hour reservation is required.

Townships (rates are per one way):

Greenfield, Pleasant, Hocking, & Berne (outside LPTS Service Area)

Advanced Rate: \$7.50

Same Day Rate: \$10.00

Violet, Liberty, Walnut, Bloom, Richland, Amanda, Rushcreek, Clearcreek, & Madison

Advanced Rate: \$15.50

Same Day Rate: \$18.00
