**Welcome:** Carrie Woody welcomed everyone to begin the meeting. Introductions were made.

**Review of October Minutes:** none presented.

**Travel Training – COTA, Pam Patula:** TAC members representing DD, SOCIL and Salvation Army attended the training. They were informed that there is potential for up to \$2,000 per person to be awarded - It is acceptable to pool money in the county. Each person was given written assignments to complete regarding what they learned and how the money will be spent. The money must be used to pay personnel to do travel training benefitting persons with disabilities and older adults. It's suggested that there be follow-up with each attendee. The TAC talked about training on actual use of transportation and awareness of the TAC.

A similar training may be held in May 2011.

**Old Business:** motion to table the goals and objections discussion made by Gary, seconded by Kelly. Motion passed.

### Agency Updates:

- Gary - ridership is on the increase and goals are more than met in Violet Township.
- Ritta - Meals on Wheels is currently serving 700+ per day, up from 550 a couple of months ago.
- Molly - 211 is very busy with Christmas food orders.
- Dr. Payne - FCDCP remains very busy with transportation. Their United Way funds were spent in June. They are submitting a letter of intent to request two replacement vans.
- Kelley – Salvation Army is very busy and The Christmas Castle has been a blessing.
- Bob – DD is hoping to switch to LPTS in August which means they can utilize passes. Peterman drivers spoke their opinions at the public forum that was recently held.
- Jan – JFS budget is not yet finalized
- Pam – COTA is planning a new building with helpful displays to assist with training
- Brooke – HEAP and other programs are keeping LFCAA busy. NSP (Neighborhood Stabilization Program) marketing is underway.
- Amy – Christmas Light Tours are being offered by LPTS starting Monday. To run M-F from 6-7pm for two weeks. Cost is \$2. Tour ends at Star Bucks where a hot

beverage will be waiting. Also, tonight BBBS event to be held for 120 kids to see lights, sing carols and distribute homemade cards at Crestview.

- **Carrie – ODOT told her that the Federal grant has been approved to fund the county-wide transportation plan. Great job! As of January 3, 2011, rides will be \$2 each way, anywhere in the county. There is still some last minute paperwork to be completed. She needs all contracts to be in writing in order to ensure reimbursement. Brochures are forthcoming and will include information regarding the travel training program. This grant must be applied for annually.**
