Project Name:	FAI-CR56-0.00, Sheridan Dr. & Tiki Lane Rehabilitation
Project Description:	This project is a "mill and fill" resurfacing with asphalt concrete of Sheridan Dr. and Tiki Lane. The project also involves spot curb repairs on Sheridan Drive, berm work along Tiki Lane, and deep pavement and subbase repairs to both streets. The deck on the Tiki Lane bridge over Ewing Run will be repaired.
Project Purpose:	Street resurfacing and bridge repairs
Project Limits:	Sheridan Dr. from W. Sixth Ave./Pleasantville Rd. (SR 188) to just north of Tiki Lane; Tiki Lane from Sheridan Dr. to Pleasantville Rd. (SR 188) Tiki Lane bridge over Ewing Run
Project Schedule:	Start: July 6, 2009 Completion: October 6, 2009 <i>NOTE: Construction is a weather dependent activity and excessive inclement weather conditions will delay the above schedule.</i>
