PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 146-12

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HOCKING COLLEGE TO GIVE THEM A USED AND/OR DECOMMISSIONED FIRE APPARATUS FOR USE IN PUMP OPERATIONS TRAINING BY THE FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES PROGRAM AT THE HOCKING DAVIS FIRE TRAINING FACILITY ACCORDING TO DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY REGULATIONS IN RETURN FOR DISPATCHER CERTIFICATION TRAINING

WHEREAS, the City has taken possession of a new pumper truck purchased with federal grant funding to replace the 1983 Pierce Dash pumper truck; and

WHEREAS, Department of Homeland Security regulations specifically state that the 1983 Pierce Dash cannot be gifted or sold to another fire department and can never be used again for emergency response in essence decommissioning the truck; and

WHEREAS, Hocking College has a Fire and Emergency Services Program and can use the truck for training students in the program on fire truck pump operations; and

WHEREAS, Hocking College will provide free training to the Lancaster Police Department Dispatchers in the area of EMT-D and/or first responder certification training in return for the gifting of the fire truck;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Hocking College for the gifting of a used and/or decommissioned fire apparatus in return for free EMT-D and/or first responder certification training of Lancaster Police Department Dispatchers.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
