

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 63-11

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 68-11

A RESOLUTION TO DECREASE THE 2011 APPROPRIATION BUDGET AND INCREASE THE 2011 ESTIMATED REVENUE FOR THE SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FUND (220)

WHEREAS, the original 2011 budget that was set in permanent resolution 158-10 was overstated and we need to reduce the budget to bring it in line along with increasing the 2011 estimated revenue to match the 2011 appropriation budget;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor increase receipts in the Special Improvement District Fund (220) for revenue account 220.000.4979 (Assessment/Downtown/SID) in the amount of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Other Resources with the County Auditor in the amount of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00) in the Special Improvement District Fund (220).

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor reduce the appropriations in the amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$10,500.00) in expense account 220.924.5923 (Spec Assessment/Spec Improv) this change will leave a revised appropriated balance of Seventy-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$79,500.00) in the expense account.

SECTION 4. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor by reducing the Certificate of Appropriations in the amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$10,500.00) in the Special Improvement District Fund (220).

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
