A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE GENERAL FUND (101)

WHEREAS, The City of Lancaster received more Hotel/Motel Tax revenue than anticipated in 2011 and due to this tax being a flow through tax that goes to the Visitors & Convention Bureau (95% of the revenue received) we need to increase the appropriations budget to be able to pay the money to the Convention Bureau.

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Nineteen Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty One Dollars (\$19,851.00) in the General Fund (101).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the General Fund (101) in expense account 101.185.5408 (Visitors & Convention Bureau) in the amount of Nineteen Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty One Dollars (\$19,851.00).

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
