

TEMPORARY ORDINANCE NO. 31-15

PERMANENT ORDINANCE NO. 28-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE WAIVER OF THE CITY RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A COUNTY RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §735.01 and §737.01 require the Service-Safety Director to become a resident of the City within six months of his or her appointment by the Mayor to the position and further provides that this residence requirement can be waived by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, In the interest of seeking the most qualified candidate for the position of Service-Safety Director it is requested that the residency requirement be expanded from City residency to Fairfield County residency;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster, pursuant to the statutory authorization set forth in Ohio Revised Code §735.01 and §737.01 and in the interest of seeking the most qualified candidate for the position of Service-Safety Director, hereby waives the City of Lancaster, Ohio residency requirement and authorizes a Fairfield County, Ohio residency requirement.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
