PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 96-17

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR, APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE WASTEWATER REVENUE FUND (604) FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH A LIGHTNING STRIKE ON JULY 22, 2017, AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF ONE THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS, these funds are used to replace damaged equipment at the Upper Hocking Pump Station due to a lightning strike;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) in the Wastewater Revenue Fund (604).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the Wastewater Revenue Fund (604) the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) into expense account 604.676.5209 (Maintenance Machine & Equipment).

SECTION 3. That City Council is hereby authorizing the issuance of one Then and Now Certificate to Worthington Industries, Inc., aka Westermans Companies.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
