PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 126-17

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SERVICE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR FLOW MONITORING AND EVALUATION FOR AREAS IN RIVER VALLEY HIGHLANDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster hired ARCADIS to complete flow monitoring and evaluation for the development of a Long Term Control Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to complete additional flow monitoring and evaluation in portions of River Valley Highlands that have Infiltration and Inflow issues;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Lancaster, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1: The Service-Safety Director is authorized to enter into a contract amendment with ARCADIS not to exceed One Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Dollars (\$178,000.00) for additional flow monitoring and evaluation for areas in River Valley Highlands.

SECTION 2: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
