PERMANENT ORDINANCE NO. 40-17

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND REPLACE LANCASTER CODIFIED ORDINANCE PART ONE – ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TITLE THREE, LEGISLATIVE, CHAPTER 111 – RULES OF COUNCIL, SECTION 111.06.1 STANDING COMMITTEES AND BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to reorganize Standing Committees to create an IT/Telecom Committee and eliminate the Public Service Boards & Administration Committee as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Part One – Administrative Code, Title Three – Legislative, Chapter 111 – Rules of Council, Section 111.06.1 Standing Committees and Boards and Commissions, be replaced pursuant to Exhibit “A” attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That existing Part One – Administrative Code, Title Three – Legislative, Chapter 111 – Rules of Council, Section 111.06.1 Standing Committees and Boards and Commissions, is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that immediate passage of this Ordinance allow appointments to be made to Standing Committees in 2018 as required by Lancaster Codified Ordinance, and is immediately effective upon execution of the Mayor.

111.06.1 STANDING COMMITTEES AND BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

The President pro tempore in the first regular meeting of the new term of Council shall submit proposed committee assignments, proposed committee chairman, and proposed appointments to boards and commissions to Council for consideration and approval. Confirmation of these appointments is required by a majority of Council. Any Council member can move to strike out one or more names and offer alternate nominations. Any such motion must be seconded and passed by a majority vote of Council. Upon motion, second, and majority confirmation, Council may change such appointments during the term.

It shall be the duty of Council not later than the first regular meeting of the new term to appoint standing committees on each of the following subjects:

- (a) **Code Enforcement & Zoning Committee**
(Certified Building Department, Code Enforcement, & Engineering)
- (b) **Economic Development Committee**
(Annexations, CDBG Program & Economic Development) [Chamber of Commerce, CIC, etc.]
- (c) **Finance Committee**
(Auditor, Treasure, Income & City Budget)
- (d) **Law Committee**
(General Legal Issues, Law Director's Office, Municipal Court, Clerk of Court, Council, Council Rules, & Council Clerk, Mayor's Office, & Service-Safety Director)
- ~~(e) **Public Service Boards & Administration Committee**
(Parks & Recreation, Olivedale, Mayor's Office, & Service Safety Director)~~
- (e) **IT/Telecom**
(Information technology and telecommunications)
- (f) **Public Works Committee**
(LDOT, Transit, & Cemetery)
- (g) **Safety Committee**
(Police & Fire)
- (h) **Service Committee**
(Gas, ~~IT/Telecom~~, Utilities Collection, Parks & Recreation, Olivedale, & Sanitation)
- (i) **Water/Water Pollution Control Committee**
(Water, Wastewater, & Storm Water)
