PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 48-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE COMMERCE STREET/QUARRY ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City prepared and submitted an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission State Capital Improvement Program(s) and to execute contracts as required through Permanent Resolution 97-17, for the Commerce Street & Quarry Road Rehabilitation in the amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$769,900.00); and

WHEREAS, the application has been approved and the City must now go out for bid and enter into a contact; and

WHEREAS, 74% of the cost to be funded by an OPWC grant up to Seven Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$769,900.00); and

WHEREAS, the remaining 26% to be funded by the 3-Mil Levy (209 Fund);

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is authorized to advertise for bids for the Commerce Street/Quarry Road Rehabilitation Project in an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$769,900.00) for use as described above.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
