A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR FACILITIES EVALUATION FOR THE LAWRENCE STREET WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Lawrence Street Water Pollution Control Facility's last major upgrades were in 1997; and

WHEREAS, much of the equipment is reaching the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, technology advances may provide operational cost savings; and

WHEREAS, Ohio EPA regulations are requiring an evaluation of phosphorus removal at the facility;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with ARCADIS US Inc., not to exceed Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000.00) for the facilities evaluation, condition assessment and preliminary design report for potential plan upgrades for the Lawrence Street Water Pollution Control Facility.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
