A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO PRELIMINARY LEGISLATION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT STATE ROUTE 188 AT THE INTERSECTION WITH DELMONT ROAD AND THE CITY OF LANCASTER'S MILL PARK DRIVE FOR PID NO. 111072

WHEREAS, this legislation is enacted by Lancaster City Council of Fairfield County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the "Local Public Agency" or "LPA", in the matter of the stated described project; and

WHEREAS, ODOT is requesting the LPA enter into Preliminary Legislation for the installation of a traffic signal at State Route 188 at the intersection with Delmont Road and the City of Lancaster's Mill Park Drive. This work will be performed as part of PID 111072, Fai-SR 188-09.55; and

WHEREAS, the LPA has determined the need for the above described project;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That Lancaster City Council, the LPA, hereby gives consent to the Preliminary Legislation for PID No. 111072, FAI-SR 188-09-55, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto or in similar form and agreement.

BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR **PID No. 111072**

SECTION I - Project Description

Pursuant to Permanent Resolution No. 141-19, Lancaster City Council of Fairfield County, Ohio, hereinafter the "Local Public Agency" or "LPA", has determined the need for the installation of traffic signal at State Route 188 at the intersection with Delmont Road and the City of Lancaster's Mill Park Drive. This work will be performed as part of PID 111072, Fai-SR 188-09.55.

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost that exceeds the Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) provided by the TID or for those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Authority to Sign

The Service-Safety Director, Paul Martin of the City of Lancaster is hereby designated and empowered on behalf of LPA to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.
