A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR THE UPPER HOCKING WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY EXPANSION PROJECT DESIGN

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster operates the Upper Hocking Water Pollution Control Facility; and

WHEREAS, the facility was put into operation in 2011 to treat 2.0 million gallons per day; and

WHEREAS, to meet growth demands in the U.S. 33 service area an expansion is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to proceed with design for the improvements to allow construction in 2022;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director be and is hereby authorized to enter into a consulting engineering agreement not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) for design and permitting services for the Upper Hocking Water Pollution Control Facility Upgrades.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
