PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 89-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO DISPENSE WITH COMPETITIVE BIDDING PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY GRANTED TO REGIONAL COUNCILS OF GOVERNMENTS IN OHIO REVISED CODE TITLE ONE CHAPTER 167 SECTION 167.081 FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROOFING MATERIALS AND SERVICES, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF ANY THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATES AS A RESULT OF THIS PROJECT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 167.081, regional councils of governments are authorized to contract for the acquisition of materials and labor and for the performance of construction projects on behalf of their members; and

WHEREAS, regional councils of government have the statutory ability to piggyback onto existing joint cooperative purchasing agreements as long as they were awarded with competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the City is a member of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC), a regional council of governments that contracts for provision of goods and services through the Master Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement (MICPA), a joint cooperative purchasing agreement administered by OMNIA Partners; and

WHEREAS, the MICPA was competitively bid and includes terms for the procurement of roofing materials and services; and

WHEREAS, the roofing materials and services are necessary to repair and re-roof portions of the City of Lancaster's Police Department, located at 130 S. Broad Street, due to leaks and damage in the evidence room and over the building's garage; and

WHEREAS, no appropriation is needed as the funding has already been appropriated;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to dispense with competitive bidding under the MICPA for the provision of roofing materials and labor necessary to perform the work required on the City of Lancaster's Police Department.

SECTION 2. That City Council hereby authorizes the issuance of any Then and Now Certificates for any invoicing as a result of this project.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
