PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 108-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT'S (HUD) FY21 HEALTHY HOMES PRODUCTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Healthy Homes Production Program is part of HUD's Healthy Homes Initiative to address housing-related hazards in a coordinated fashion; and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be used to identify and remediate housing-related health and safety hazards in privately owned, low-income rental and/or owner-occupied housing, especially in units where families with children, older adults sixty-two (62) years and older, or families with persons with disabilities reside; and

WHEREAS, the minimum request from the Healthy Homes Production program is One Million Dollars, the maximum request is Two Million Dollars, and the grant period is 42 months ; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, these funds would build upon the FY20 Lead Hazard Control grant the City of Lancaster received from HUD; and

WHEREAS, a 10% match is required and Community Development Block Grant funds can be used toward this match; and

WHEREAS, suspension of this legislation is requested due to the application deadline of September 21, 2021;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Community Development Department is hereby authorized to apply for grant funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) FY21 Healthy Homes Production Program.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
