PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 28-14

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT KNOWN AS FAI-CR54/CR68-VAR, PID 94748, FAIR/COLLINS IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City has programmed both West Fair Avenue between the railroad and Memorial Drive, and Collins Road between Fair Avenue and the railroad for resurfacing and ancillary work with the Ohio Department of Transportation for federal surface transportation program funds to construct said project, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lancaster has previously passed Permanent Resolution No. 137-12 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a LPA Federal Local-Let Agreement with said Department of Transportation for the purpose of constructing the improvement project herein above described, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lancaster has previously passed Permanent Resolution No. 105-13 authorizing the submittal of a loan application to the Ohio Public Works Commission to cover the local match to the aforesaid federal surface transportation program funds, and;

WHEREAS, there exists a real and present need to perform the improvement project;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a construction agreement with the lowest and best bidder to complete the project FAI-CR54/CR68-VAR, PID 94748 in an amount not to exceed one million five hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$1,570,000.00).

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from passage and approval by the Mayor.
