PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 44-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR THE PLEASANTVILLE ROAD WATER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the existing water main on Pleasantville Road, between Ewing Street and Wesley Way, has experienced numerous line breaks in recent years due to its advanced age; and

WHEREAS, this existing main is only 6" in diameter and very likely undersized; and

WHEREAS, a 16" diameter water main is needed on Pleasantville Road between Wheeling Road and Wesley Way as a precondition for the removal of the East Side Standpipe, which is at the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, engineering services are needed to design and construct the necessary improvements to the Pleasantville Road water main;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is authorized to enter into an engineering agreement not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) for engineering services on the Pleasantville Road Water Line Replacement.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
