PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 71-22

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY (LPA) FEDERAL LOCAL LET PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE RESURFACING OF SIXTH AVENUE FROM MAPLE STREET TO CHERRY STREET

WHEREAS, the project known as East Sixth Avenue, FAI-CR502-1.34, PID 114406, is scheduled as the next Surface Transportation Program ("STP") funded project; and

WHEREAS, STP funds will pay for ~~80%~~ 95% of the project costs and the remaining balance will be funded by the 3 Mil Levy from the 2009 Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor or his designee must enter into a LPA Federal Local Let Project Agreement with ODOT to start this project; and

WHEREAS, legislation to go out to bid will be requested at a later date as the project will be bid in Fiscal year 2023;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to enter into a LPA Federal Local LET Project Agreement with ODOT for the resurfacing of Sixth Avenue from Maple Street to Cherry Street.

SECTION 2. This Project is known as East Sixth Avenue, FAI-CR502-1.34, PID 114406, and is scheduled to be the next STP funded project.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
