

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 92-22

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 89-22

A RESOLUTION TO DECREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE LANCASTER POLICE DEPARTMENT'S SALARIES FUND, INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN ITS CONTRACTUAL SERVICES FUND, APPROVE ANY THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATES AS NECESSARY, AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the air conditioning in the Lancaster Police Department ("LPD") is no longer functional in a large portion of the building, which has resulted in a significant temperature increase inside the building at a time when the outdoor temperature is expected to continue to climb as well; and

WHEREAS, restoring the air conditioning immediately is not possible due to mechanical issues, supply chain problems, and financial concerns, so to maintain some degree of climate control, LPD reached out to multiple vendors for interim solutions; and

WHEREAS, only Limbach Company LLC was able to offer a temporary cooling unit for lease through the warmer months to reduce the indoor air temperature sufficiently for the public and employees to continue using the facility until a long-term solution is identified in the cooler months; and

WHEREAS, LPD currently has approximately One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) extra money budgeted for officer wages in fund 1001.3250.51002 (Salaries/Staff Police) as a result of fewer hires, of which Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) can be used to cover the expense of the temporary cooling unit which will be paid out of LPD's contractual services fund, 1001.3250.52034 (Contractual Serv – Police);

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor complete an appropriation decrease and increase for the following accounts:

DECREASE:

1001.3250.51002, Salaries/Staff	\$45,000.00
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INCREASE:

1001.3250.52034, Contract Services	\$45,000.00
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SECTION 2. That City Council issue a Then and Now Certificate for purchase orders coming from this project.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
