

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 3-23

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 26-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF CITY PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED VIA AUCTION OR INTERNET AUCTIONS FOR 2023

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 721.15 the City is authorized to dispose of property that is obsolete, unfit, or no longer needed by an annual auction or auctions if City Council adopts, each calendar year, a resolution expressing its intent to sell property by auction; and

WHEREAS, furthermore, Ohio Revised Code 721.15(D) authorizes sales by internet auction for all municipal personal property, vehicles, equipment, tools, and supplies that are obsolete, unfit, or no longer needed if City Council passes an annual resolution authorizing internet sales; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. **Auction:**

- a. That City Council hereby approves of a 2023 auction or auctions, if necessary, of materials, supplies, vehicles, equipment, etc., which are deemed by departments, or the administration as no longer needed by the City. The City Administration shall determine specifics of the auction and shall determine the distribution of funds from the auction as directed by the Service-Safety Director.

SECTION. **Internet Auction Sales:**

- a. City Council authorizes the sale of any used personal property, vehicles, equipment, tools, and supplies by internet sale as approved by the authority's representative, the Service-Safety Director.
- b. Conditions of internet sales:
 1. Listing period: 15-45 days as determined by the Service-Safety Director; and
 2. Conducted by whom: Auction shall be conducted by City itself or through the assistance of third-party vendors as determined by City Administration; and
 3. Terms of Sale: Cashier's check, or other method determined by the Service-Safety Director and/or third-party vendor with approval of Service-Safety Director; and
 4. Delivery: Pickup or delivery as determined by the Service-Safety Director and/or third-party vendor with approval of Service-Safety Director.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
