

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 42-23

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 46-23

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE IN THE FIRE IMPACT DISTRICT 1 FUND (3022) AND TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY AUDITOR, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATE

WHEREAS, Permanent Resolution 91-21 passed on July 19, 2021, to encumber funds from the Fire Impact District 1 Fund (3022) for the purchase of a 2022 Horton Medic Unit; and

WHEREAS, purchasing the 2022 medic unit at that time helped the City avoid an 8% price increase and other delays in the supply chain; and

WHEREAS, while waiting to take delivery of the 2022 medic unit, it was discovered that the funds were never actually encumbered on a purchase order and subsequently went back into the carryover money; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor for the Fire Impact District 1 Fund (3022) in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars and Sixty-Five Cents (\$281,914.65).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in expense account 3022.9270.56050 (Vehicle Fire Impact) in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars and Sixty-Five Cents (\$281,914.65) in the Fire Impact District 1 Fund (3022).

SECTION 3. That Lancaster City Council approves a Then and Now Certificate in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars and Sixty-Five Cents (\$281,914.65) for the purchase of a 2022 Horton Medic Unit.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
