

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 90-14

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 88-14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE BALDWIN RUN STREAM RESTORATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, Baldwin Run is a major waterway in the City of Lancaster; and

WHEREAS, the water quality in Baldwin Run is impacted due to stream channelization; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio awarded a grant to the City of Lancaster to improve stream quality through restoration project;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. The Service-Safety Director is authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) for construction of the Baldwin Run Stream Restoration Project.

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Other Sources and Appropriations with the County Auditor in the Improvement Account 619 Stormwater Utility Reserve in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00).

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor increase receipts in the Improvement Fund 619.005.4301 (Stream Projects) Stormwater Utility Reserve in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00).

SECTION 4. That the City of Lancaster appropriate from the un-appropriated balance in the Stormwater Utility Reserve Fund in the expense account 619.005.5606 (Stream Projects) in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00).

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
