PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 95-14

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGAR GROVE'S APPLICATION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INNOVATION FUND SEEKING FUNDS FOR THE COMPLETION OF A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR EVALUATING THE ALTERNATIVES AVAILABLE FOR FUTURE WATER SUPPLY INCLUDING A REGIONAL CONNECTION TO THE CITY OF LANCASTER'S SOUTH WATER TREATMENT PLANT

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster owns and operates the Lancaster South Water Treatment Plant located approximately two miles north of the Village of Sugar Grove; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Sugar Grove intends to apply for funding through the Ohio Development Services Agency, Local Government Innovation Fund, to evaluate the feasibility and cost efficiencies associated with connecting to the Lancaster South Water Treatment Plant versus upgrading its own existing water treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster desires to cooperate and collaborate with the Village of Sugar Grove in the furtherance of its evaluation of the feasibility and cost efficiencies associated with connecting to the Lancaster South Water Treatment Plant versus upgrading its own existing water treatment plant, in hopes of supplying the Village with water upon terms and conditions to be agreed upon in the future.

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That City Council hereby supports the Village of Sugar Grove in their efforts to obtain funding to evaluate the feasibility and cost efficiencies associated with connecting to the Lancaster South Water Treatment Plant versus upgrading its own existing water treatment plant.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
