

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 96-14

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 97-14

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE OFFICIAL INTENT AND REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE BORROWER) TO REIMBURSE ITS LDOT IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE WEST FAIR/COLLINS ROAD IMPROVEMENT, CQ15R WITH THE PROCEEDS OF THE TAX EXEMPT DEBT OF THE STATE OF OHIO

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. The City of Lancaster, Fairfield County reasonably expects to receive reimbursement for the project named West Fair/Collins Road Improvement as set forth in Appendix A of the Project Agreement with the proceeds of bonds to be issued by the State of Ohio.

SECTION 2. The maximum aggregate principle amount of bonds, other than for costs of issuance, expected to be issued by the State of Ohio for reimbursement to the local subdivision is Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$370,300.00).

SECTION 3. The Clerk of the Council of the City of Lancaster, Fairfield County is hereby directed to file a copy of this Resolution with the City of Lancaster for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein and to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.

SECTION 4. The City of Lancaster, Fairfield County finds and determines that all formal actions of this City concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the City of Lancaster, Fairfield County and that all deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

APPENDIX A

PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND COMPLETION SCHEDULE

1) PROJECT DESCRIPTION / PHYSICAL SCOPE:

The Project, for which the provision of financial assistance is the subject of this Agreement, is hereby defined and described as follows:

a) PROJECT NAME: West Fair/Collins Road Improvement

b) SPECIFIC LOCATION: West Fair Avenue will be resurfaced between the I&O Railway Crossing and Memorial Drive to the east. Collins Road will be resurfaced between Fair Avenue and the I&O railway crossing to the north.

(Project Location Zip Code - 43130-)

c) PROJECT TYPE; MAJOR COMPONENTS: The work includes a "mill and fill" resurfacing of both streets with the placement of asphalt concrete in two courses. Pavement repairs will be made to both streets to correct base and subbase problems and to properly repair utility patches. Replacement of pavement markings will be included for both streets. Traffic signs will be replaced to meet the new retro-reflectivity standards for traffic signs. On West Fair Avenue the planing depth will be 2.5 inches with the resurfacing in two courses using Item 448 mix design. Curb ramps will be installed at most intersections to meet ADA requirements. Spot curb repairs are also included. Collins Road will be milled to 1 inch deep, except in the FEMA designated floodway where it will be 3 inches deep. Two courses of Item 442 will be placed to a total of 3 inches thick for the full length of the work. Berm material with a safety edge will be placed on both sides of the street. See engineer's estimate in project application for approved bid items and quantities.

d) PHYSICAL DIMENSIONAL CHARACTERISTICS: West Fair Avenue is 36 feet wide and paving length is 5,458 feet long. Collins Road is 24 feet wide and paving length is 6,463 feet long.

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2) PROJECT SCHEDULE:

The Project, for which the provision of financial assistance is the subject of this Agreement, shall be pursued and completed in accordance with the following schedule:

NOTE: Construction must begin within 30 days of the date set forth herein for the start of construction, or this Agreement may become null and void, at the sole option of the Director. However, the Recipient may apply to the Director in writing for an extension of the date to initiate construction. The Recipient shall specify the reasons for the delay in the start of construction and provide the Director with a new start of construction date. The Director will review such requests for extensions and may extend the start date, providing that the Project can be completed within a reasonable time frame.

The information detailed in this Appendix A shall serve as the basis for Project monitoring purposes and for determining Project acceptance upon its completion. In the event that circumstances require a change in physical scope, such changes must be approved through the execution of a formal Amendment to this Project Agreement.
