

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 101-14

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 104-14

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE, AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (320)

WHEREAS, the roof on the Lancaster Police Department building needs replaced and the repairs will be paid out of the Capital Improvement Fund (320); and

WHEREAS, the Lancaster Police Department will pay \$85,000.00 into the Capital Improvement Fund from their Drug Enforcement Account;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the Fairfield County Auditor in the amount of One Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-One Dollars (\$137,251.00) in the Capital Improvement Fund (320).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the expense account 320.925.5620 (Improvements) for the amount of One Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-One Dollars (\$137,251.00) in the Capital Improvement Fund (320).

SECTION 3. That the Lancaster City Council accepts a payment from the Drug Enforcement Account into the Capital Improvement Fund (320) of Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) to help pay for the new roof on the Lancaster Police Department.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
