A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN ASSESSMENT EQUALIZATION BOARD TO HEAR OBJECTIONS RELATIVE TO THE SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT CONSISTING OF MAIN, COLUMBUS AND BROAD STREETS, BETWEEN CERTAIN TERMINI

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That three disinterested freeholders of this City, are appointed to act as an Assessment Equalization Board to hear and determine all timely written objections to the estimated special assessments for the cost of improving Main, Columbus and Broad Streets, between certain termini, and to equalize those special assessments as to them seems proper in accordance with law and with Resolution Temporary Number 102-13, Permanent Number _____ adopted on July 29, 2013.

SECTION 2 That the Board shall first meet for the purpose at Olivedale, 253 Boving Road, Lancaster, Ohio on Tuesday, October 22, 2013 at 7:00 p.m., and upon the completion of its hearings and equalization shall report the equalized special assessments to Council. The Law Director shall, at least five days prior to the first meeting, send a notice of the hearing by certified mail to all persons who filed timely written objections.

SECTION 3. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
