

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 2-13

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 20-13

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DISPOSITION OF CITY PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED VIA AUCTION OR INTERNET AUCTIONS FOR 2013

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster disposes of property no longer needed by an annual auction or auctions pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 721.15; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 721.15(D) allows municipal legislative authority to pass an annual resolution authorizing internet sales of all used City personal property, vehicles, and or equipment not needed for public use or is obsolete or unfit for use for which it was acquired;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. **Auction:**

- a. That City Council hereby approves of a 2013 auction or auctions if necessary of materials, supplies, vehicles, etc, which are deemed by departments or the administration as no longer needed by the City. The City Administration shall determine specifics of the auction and shall determine the distribution of funds from the auction as directed by the Service-Safety Director.

SECTION. **Internet Auction Sales:**

- a. The City Council authorizes the sale of any used personal property, vehicles, and equipment by internet sale as approved by the authority's representative, the Service-Safety Director.
- b. Conditions of internet sales:
 - 1. Listing period: 15-45 days as determined by the Service-Safety Director; and
 - 2. Conducted by whom: Auction shall be conducted by City; and
 - 3. Terms of Sale: cashier's check, or other method determined by the Service-Safety Director; and
 - 4. Delivery: pickup or delivery as determined by the Service-Safety Director.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
