PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 61-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT APPLICATION AND TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS AS REQUIRED FOR THE GLASSCO PARK DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Union/Mulberry/Brumfield area has experienced severe stormwater flooding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster has submitted a pre-application for a hazard mitigation grant to the Ohio Emergency Management Agency for the area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster has been authorized to submit a grant application for Federal Emergency Management Agency Mitigation Funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,978,804 in federal funds and \$329,800 in state funds; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. As a potential subgrantee to the State of Ohio in the Hazard Mitigation Grant program, the City of Lancaster hereby commits the matching funds necessary for the Glassco Park Drainage Improvements project located at West Sixth Avenue.

SECTION 2. Upon FEMA project approval, the City of Lancaster is responsible for a minimum of 12.5% of the total project cost and all costs exceeded the maximum state and federal funds of \$2,308,604 and intends to utilize Stormwater Utility Funds as certified by the City Auditor.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the Ohio Emergency Management Agency for funds as described above.

SECTION 4. The Mayor is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
