A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS AS REQUIRED FOR THE BALDWIN RUN STREAM RESTORATION

WHEREAS, Baldwin Run is a major waterway in the City of Lancaster; and

WHEREAS, the water quality in Baldwin Run is impacted due to stream channelization; and

WHEREAS, The State of Ohio offers grants to communities to improve stream quality through restoration projects; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for a 319 Grant for the Baldwin Run Stream Restoration Project in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
