City of Lancaster Road Race Policy

The City of Lancaster Road Race policy is designed to allow the opportunity to organize a successful and safe road race while addressing the following key components:

- Promoting the safety of the participants, volunteers and bystanders.
- Minimizing the disruption to on-going traffic and commerce in the City.
- Reducing the City resources and cost required to support such events.

While working with representatives of the local running community, the City has identified a set of preferred courses that are designed to help meet the goals noted above. Use of these preferred courses is strongly recommended and will facilitate the application and approval process for future race events in the City of Lancaster. Alternative race courses may still be proposed, however, the application and approval process will be more rigorous. If approved, organizers may expect additional management effort in addition to incremental fees for race support by the City.

Race event applications, including supporting documents and maps of preferred courses, may be obtained from the City of Lancaster, Office of the Service-Safety Director or on-line at www.ci.lancaster.oh.us.
